REFLECTION, THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER (C)

The story of the resurrection is a wonderful story. It all started with the angel's announcement that he had risen and it was completely abnormal, as everyone believed that with his crucifixion, death and burial it was all over. Yet with the news of his rising we now have a complete reversal of the situation. Interestingly, Jesus himself did not delay in seizing the opportunity to construct his narrative by going around to show himself to his disciples, to revive their hope and confidence. With persistent effort on the part of Jesus in appearing to his disciples in different ways, there is an upsurge of confidence among the disciples as they now also begin to tell the story of the resurrection themselves, having had the opportunity to encounter the Lord himself. Such was the case with the two disciples on their way to Emmaus. Once they rejoined the eleven they started sharing their experience of their encounter with the risen Lord.

When we genuinely encounter the risen Lord we do not remain the same, as we are transformed into courageous witnesses of the gospel; we lose our excessive self-consciousness as we come under the powerful influence of the Holy Spirit, so that it is no longer we who live, but Christ who lives and operates in us through the power of his Spirit. Because our lives are animated by the Spirit of the risen Lord, we are able to live the life of Christ and so face the challenges of life with total resignation to the will of God. Because we are led by the spirit we are not only able to overcome the world, but we are able to also master ourselves such as not to allow sin to reign in our lives.

The Lord knows that without him we can do nothing. That is why he is so generous in showing himself to us and sharing his resurrection life with us. We really need to examine ourselves today whether we have truly encountered the risen Lord. Have I seen the risen Lord? Can I feel the impact of his resurrection in my life? Having encountered him do I realize my burden as a witness of his resurrection? Unless we have encountered him and accept the burden of being his witnesses in the world by living a life dedicated to God, we cannot say we are really his disciples; we cannot truly say we are Easter people. So let us ask him to come into our lives afresh and fill us with his resurrection life, so that moved by his spirit we can also share our story of our encounter with him with others.
